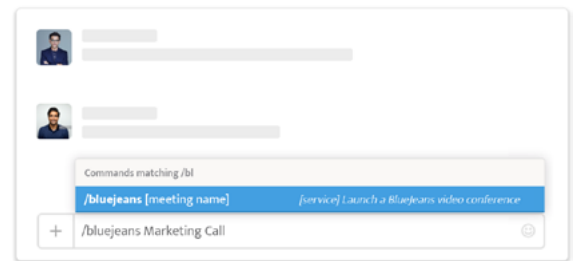
Launch meetings and share post-meeting summaries directly from Slack with a simple click or command

BlueJeans and Slack work together to enable users in a group chat, channel, or direct message to easily join an HD video meeting for a fast and secure onramp to team productivity.

BlueJeans Slash Command

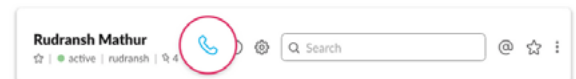
Use the “/bluejeans” slash command to launch a BlueJeans Meeting from any Slack Direct Message, Group, or Channel.

- Type: “/bluejeans” to create a link to your account’s Personal Meeting
- Type: “/bluejeans [meeting name]” to create an ad hoc meeting with a unique ID and chosen title
- Type: “/bluejeans [email@domain.com]” to send an invitation to your Personal Meeting, invitees don’t need a BlueJeans or Slack account



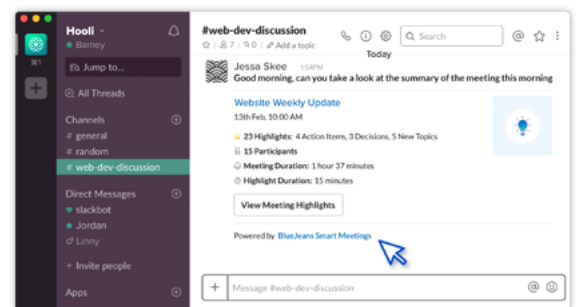
Make BlueJeans Calls Directly from Slack

Click the Slack phone icon to initiate a meeting in your personal room or create an ad hoc meeting with a unique meeting ID from any Slack Channel, Group, or direct message.



Share Highlights and Post-Meeting Summaries

Share post-meeting summaries with any private Slack channel. These automatic notifications keep teammates informed about the value of each meeting and provide a direct link to the playback page to watch the meeting highlight reel.



Integrating BlueJeans with Slack
